Yoel Everett is a 4th year PhD student in the UO Clinical Psychology program and a member of the Science and Treatment of Affect Regulation Team (START) Lab. He is interested in transdiagnostic aspects of parental psychopathology, specifically parental emotion dysregulation and its influence on parenting and child mental health outcomes. His current work focuses on integrating Dialectical Behavior Therapy Skills with Parent Training, as part of an effort to develop an integrated parent mental health + parent training intervention for families in which a parent has psychopathology.



Kavya Mudiam is a 2nd year PhD student in the Clinical Psychology program at the University of Oregon. Her work within the Center for Digital Mental Health focuses on predictors and treatments for adolescent mental health along with the utilization of digital technology to monitor and address mental health symptoms.
